**ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Under the supervision of the Airport Public Safety Chief, the Airport PSO has the operational responsibility for directing all police, fire, and emergency medical response requirements of the Public Safety Department in accordance with Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) and Transportation Security Administration (TSA) regulatory requirements.
- Enforces compliance with Airport Rules and Regulations and Department Policies and Procedures. Ensures compliance with federal regulations related to airport operations; airport law enforcement, fire/rescue, and airport security (FAR Part 139 and FAR Part 1542).

**QUALIFICATIONS AND EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS**
